

## Appropriate use of district funds

For example:

In 2014 The **OSBA** sent an **oath** of office to be used to swear in the new school board members pulls from R.C. 3313.10 (link to OSBA oath available at <http://www.ohioschoolboards.org/oath-of-office-5> (The below oath is no longer posted to their website)

Here is the 2014 OSBA Oath of Office **(do not use this one it is illegal)**.

*Do you solemnly swear (or affirm) that you will support the Constitution of the State of Ohio; and that you will faithfully and impartially discharge your duties as members of the board of education of the \_\_\_\_\_ school district, \_\_\_\_\_ County, Ohio, to the best of your ability, and in accordance with the laws now in effect and hereafter to be enacted, during your continuance in said office, and until your successor is elected and qualified?*

*The answer is : "I do."*

**One small problem**, this oath is not compliant with the law because it omits the swearing to support the Constitution of the United States. Wow, pretty big mistake.

### **R.C. 3313.10 Oath of office of member states:**

“Before entering upon the duties of his office each person elected or appointed a member of a board of education shall take an oath to support the Constitution of the United States and the constitution of this state and that he will perform faithfully the duties of his office. Such oath may be administered by the treasurer or any member of the board.”

OSBA’s oath leaves off supporting the support for the **Constitution of the United States**.

NSBLC encourages school boards to use this oath. This oath matches the ORC 3313.10.

*Do you solemnly swear (or affirm) that you will support the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Ohio; and that you will faithfully and impartially discharge your duties as members of the board of education of the \_\_\_\_\_ School District, \_\_\_\_\_ County, Ohio, to the best of your ability, and in accordance with the laws now in effect and hereafter to be enacted, during your continuance in said office, and until your successor is elected and qualified, so help me God.*

*The answer is : "I do."*

“So help me God” removed from Congress, your local governments actions, courts and your school districts Oath.

All persons being sworn in can put it in for themselves.
