RE: Corporate grooming and exploitation of school children

Dear Pastor [REDACTED]

Recently, I attended a meeting regarding the *corporate marketing of obscenity to children* in schools, even in the elementary grades. You could rightly ask, "How could that possibly be?"

It is due, in part, to the change in the delivery model of education. School districts purchase software to convert the conventional instructional materials to remote lessons. Embedded in the lessons are backdoors to research databases that host all manner of obscene materials that are being used to "normalize" un-Godly deviant beliefs and behaviors.

To verify the truth of what was presented to me, I wanted to access the "research" tools first-hand, yet I had no expectation that public school authorities would permit me to access their computer systems. Accordingly, I met with [REDACTED] for his assistance, and he informed me that [REDACTED] IT system is strictly in-house. Like you, I am thankful [REDACTED] students cannot gain access to obscenity through *school equipment*. Yet, it is important to note that these so-called "research" databases are accessible from computers in public schools and remotely through state equipment on loan to remote learners, via public libraries, personal computers, and phones, but my primary focus is on what children have access to through their schools. In a best-case scenario, some public school districts may have innocently purchased one of the many databases solely for the purpose of converting conventional curricula to an online format. And although [REDACTED] is not dispensing obscene and pornographic materials, the students may be exposed to it through their non-[REDACTED] friends.

I have attached links below. They are included only to share the scope and magnitude of what is now readily available to schoolchildren. Even though the screen shots are blurred, they could cause people to stumble. Discernment should be paramount in viewing or sharing the links.

With those cautions in mind, I would appreciate your thoughts regarding the most appropriate way to inform parents and school board members about the obscenity that is now readily available to students in and out of the classroom – without actually sharing obscene materials.

Ohio Revised Code Obscenity: 2907.31

(C) (1) It is an **affirmative defense** to a charge under this section, involving material or a performance that is obscene or harmful to juveniles, that the material or performance was furnished or presented for a bona fide medical, scientific, educational, governmental, judicial, or other proper purpose, by a physician, psychologist, sociologist, scientist, teacher, librarian, clergyman, prosecutor, judge, or other proper person.
