

# School Board Member Pledge

I believe all students, parents and citizens have rights which must be protected. The U.S. Constitution and the Constitution of the State of \_\_\_\_\_ recognize the unalienable rights of all individuals who reside or travel through our state.

I will support and defend all unalienable rights of the individual including those enumerated in the U.S. Constitution and the State of \_\_\_\_\_ Constitution which include the right to choose one's own medical needs, course of treatment and medical intervention(s) if necessary.

I will support and defend student rights to privacy, as well as make sure parents and students know they have the right not to answer any questions which are not academically related to the learning process.

I will demand the education system for whom I am working to stay in their lane focusing on academic excellence and not social emotional teaching.

I will strongly discourage participation in the distortions of American history, sexualized curriculum, gender confusion, the discriminatory content advancing concepts of 'Equity' rather than equality of opportunity.

I will support and affirm the rights of all parents to participate in the education of their children by requiring notification of objectionable content in school curriculum. "Objectionable material" is to be determined by a district curriculum oversight committee. The composition of this committee should contain a majority of parents, the rest made up of school board members and staff.

I will support and defend the rights of all parents and/or legal guardians to be notified should it be determined a need exists to ask their child questions which may be considered invasive, personal, and potentially personally incriminating.

I further support the requirement that a parent (and/or legal guardian), after the determination has been made of the necessity of asking a child invasive, personal, or incriminating question, be present at the time such questions are to be posed to the child.

I will support the requirement, two weeks prior to the commencement of each semester or quarter, that parents be supplied with a reading list as well as a copy of the instructors' class plan/lesson plan reflecting subject matter to be covered in the upcoming semester/quarter as well as materials and other resources to be used.

I support the requirement that existing materials in a library presently accessible to students be reviewed by the curriculum oversight committee for age and academic appropriateness. Furthermore, I support the requirement that the curriculum oversight committee be presented with any purchase order or reimbursement request of new library materials prior to their purchase. Should materials be donated to any library, a list of the materials shall be reviewed by the curriculum oversight committee prior to these materials being made accessible to students, or available for incorporation into the curriculum.
